AXIS D6210 Air Quality Sensor integration

AXIS D6210 can monitor indoor air quality, humidity, temperature, and air pollutants as well as detect
vaping and smoking. The support includes two dashboards that provide the latest and historical
information from the various sensors. You can use sensor data to issue alerts or trigger other devices
when alarm conditions are reached.

AXIS 18307-VE Network Video Intercom integration

• AXIS 18307–VE can be used as an IP reader in AXIS Camera Station Pro. The intercom comes with 4K video, two-way audio communication, and a customizable touchscreen display.

Smart search 2: Swaying object filter

 You can now filter out swaying objects such as foliage or other objects with fairly constant but limited movement, cutting down on incoming data and storage requirements.

Improved certificate handling on devices

• Clicking a certificate error status in Add devices and Management list now opens a dialog to handle the error on the affected device. The dialog allows you to view the current certificate on the device and gives you the option to trust the certificate or issue a new one.

New Body worn settings page

The settings page allows you to configure:

- The default storage location for body worn recordings
- A folder for storing rejected recordings
- How long to retain rejected recordings

Secure Entry: Mass distribution of QR and mobile credentials

You can now select multiple cardholders from access management and email them their associated QR
or mobile credentials at once. The email only goes out to the selected cardholders who have that
credential.



Axis Secure Remote Access v2

The next generation of remote access solution, Axis Secure Remote Access v2, further improves security
by adding WebRTC-communication, multi factor authentication and use of individual My Axis accounts.
We're discontinuing the current version in September 2025, and we strongly recommend that you
upgrade to Axis Secure Remote Access v2 before that. See Axis Secure Remote Access v2 in the user

Event categories

• You can now assign event categories to any recording to set longer retention times, overriding the retention time of the camera. See *Event categories* in the user manual for more information.

Access control in the mobile app

- With a door configured in a split view, you can:
 - Open the door for visitors.
 - Activate a lockdown.
 - Receive notifications when someone opens or closes a door.
 - Receive alarms, for example, when a door is open for too long, or opened by force.

Remote service restart

Select any audio channel

 You can now select any audio input from devices with two inputs, such as the AXIS FA54 and the AXIS D3110 Connectivity hub, and associate them with a video source.

3x3 split view on AXIS D1110

Action rules

- The new Live view trigger occurs when a user opens a specific camera's video stream. You can use this, for example, to let people near a camera know that someone's watching them using the camera's LEDs. See Create live view triggers in the AXIS Camera Station Pro user manual for more information.
- The new Virtual I/O action triggers a specific virtual input port on a device. See Create virtual I/O actions in the AXIS Camera Station Pro user manual for more information.
- When you add a camera with an indication LED, like AXIS Q9307, AXIS Camera Station Pro creates an action rule with the new Live view trigger and Virtual I/O action.

More searchable vehicle properties

• New vehicle properties in data search, like color, direction, and country, make it easier to find the event you're looking for. See *Data search in the AXIS Camera Station Pro User manual* for more information.

Secure entry

- You can now turn on or off access rules in the access management system using action rules. See *Create* access control actions in the AXIS Camera Station Pro user manual for more information.
- With the added support for AXIS A4612 Bluetooth Reader and the new mobile credential in AXIS
 Camera Station Mobile App, cardholders can now unlock doors using their phone. See *Use a mobile* phone to unlock a door in the AXIS Camera Station Pro user manual for more information.
- The new door type monitoring door is different from a regular door with a door monitor. A regular door with a door monitor supports locks and readers but requires a door controller. A monitoring door supports one door position sensor but only requires a network I/O relay module connected to a door controller. Replace a camera with multiple views

- You can now replace a camera with more than one view as long as the replacement camera has the same number of views as the old camera.

- AXIS Camera Station Pro is compatible with the new AXIS A9210 Network I/O Relay Module. Using a single IP address, you can expand the unit to 128 I/Os. Using the device event option in action rules, you can easily integrate the inputs and outputs into AXIS Camera Station Pro.

- Includes predefined views, PTZ, and preset positions.

Axis data insights dashboard

- Visualizes analytics data from your devices
- Analytics data includes crossline counting and occupancy in area scenarios configured in AXIS Object Analytics on the devices in your system.

Replace a camera

- You can now replace an Axis camera while keeping compatible settings and existing recordings.
- This feature works best with cameras of the same model or similar ones.

Kerberos authentication

- AXIS Camera Station Pro uses the Microsoft Negotiate protocol (SPNEGO) which means that Kerberos is the preferred and default authentication protocol.

View components

Optimize for storage

- Optimize for storage uses more advanced compression tools to save additional storage compared to the default Zipstream setting.
- This profile can further reduce the bitrate even for scenes with a lot of motion.

Double swipe

- The double-swipe allows a cardholder override the current state of a door.
- For example, they can use it to unlock a door outside the regular schedule, which is more convenient than going into the system to unlock the door.

- The two-person rule requires two people to swipe their cards to gain access.
